Harewood road entrance is for pedestrians only. Vehicles must NOT stop here to off load, but continue via the swimming baths entrance to the car park where it's safe to dismount. All winners must make their way to the stage for the prize giving.

There is a fee of £20 for business/advertising vehicles. Entry to the procession for Schools, Community Groups and Charities is FREE.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

All participants who collect monies in the procession should note that all monies are and will remain the sole property of Skipton Charities Gala and may **NOT** be collected on behalf of any other charity or organisation whatsoever, as set out in the conditions of the street collection licence granted to us for the day.

1. No competitor may enter more than one class.
2. Classes are judged before the procession at 11:45am
3. Prize money to be collected from the treasurer's caravan on the field. Classes 1, 2 and 4 make your way to the stage where a voucher will be presented for you to redeem.
All monies must be collected on the day before 5pm; prizes not collected will be donated to charity.

Competitors must be in Westmoreland Street no later than 11:30am with the Class card attached to their right arm and a number displayed in the vehicle. The number will be handed to the driver on arrival. The competitors must distinctly state on entry form the character they represent and the class they wish to compete in.

The Committee reserve themselves the power to refuse entry or alter any of the prizes in cash or goods in any of the classes.

The officials of the procession ask all competitors, especially the vehicular traffic classes, to conform to requests and instructions of the marshals in Westmoreland Street as to their position in the procession.

All participants should keep the procession moving to avoid hold-ups.
Dismount of vehicles is only permitted at the swimming baths car park and NOT on Gargrave Road.

The committee cannot be held responsible for the participants entering the procession. Entrants are advised to provide their own insurance cover.
